Participation in sweepstakes exclusively through the purchase of services or goods

Anyone who combines participation in a sweepstake with the purchase of services or goods at prices that are at most in line with the market for the purpose of short-term sales promotion does not require a permit, provided there is no risk of excessive gambling (e.g. Suisse Art. 1 para. 2 lit. d BGS).

Example: In the retail trade, every purchaser of chocolate is automatically entered into a draw for a voucher for an annual subscription to a fitness center. The chocolate costs the same as in the previous year, when the purchase was not associated with participation in a raffle.

Pakapoo.online is a short term promotion of the NFT Gallery SHOP <https://ghostmarket.io/account/user/sawi6p/>The pakapoo.online client purchases a digital image which automatically enters into draw to win a digital currency. The digital image would cost the same as if the client would not participate in the sweepstake.

Further, in Switzerland and many other countries do not qualify cryptocurrencies as legal tender.
